As per Govt. of India directives, the Anti-ragging Committee of an institute is a very important part of any Educational Institution. As per the UGC guidelines under the Act of 1956, which was modified later as UGC regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in higher Educational Institutions, 2009, establishment of Anti-Ragging Committee is mandatory for every educational institution. The RERF Group of Institutes has also set up an anti-ragging Committee to deal with issues related to instances of ragging in particular related to our Group of Institutes.

The salient objectives of the Committee are as follows:

- To prohibit any conduct in any form by anyone which has the ill effect of ragging a fresher or any other student.
- To impart awareness among the students about the negative consequences of ragging.
- To keep a constant vigil in and around the college campus so as to prevent the occurrence of ragging.
- To address matters related to ragging immediately and taken necessary action as advised by the committee.
- Anti-Ragging Committee executive meeting will be held at least twice in an academic year.

The objectives are fulfilled by keeping a strict vigil and imparting awareness among the students about the negative consequences of ragging.

Additionally, the Committee also takes up issues related to instances of ragging in order to resolve the issues in the non-partisan way.
